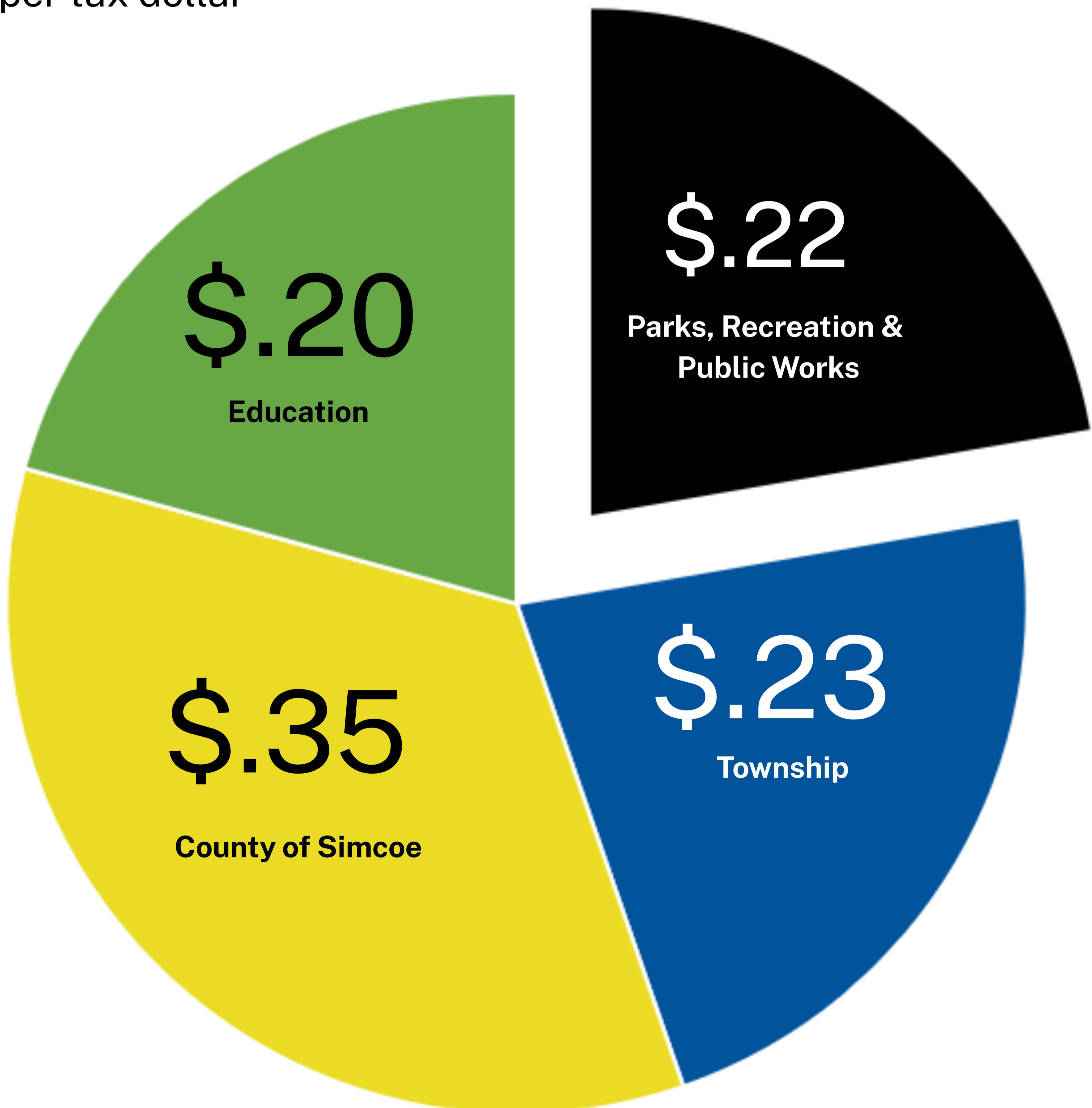

Core Functions

Roads

- To maintain all roads under the jurisdiction of Adjala/Tosorontio in a safe condition for the motoring public.
- Snow Plowing
- Grading of gravel roads
- Dust control
- Drainage
- Roadside grass cutting, tree brushing & removal
- Sign maintenance (Regulatory & Warning Signs)
- Road improvements
- Bridge maintenance & replacement

Parks

- Maintain all parks and equipment
- Maintain ball diamonds
- Maintain washrooms

Water

- With the assistance from OCWA maintains safe drinking water to 6 municipal owned water systems.

Legislative Requirements

- Ontario Minimum Maintenance Standards (MMS) for the levels of services provided.
- Drainage act.
- 2025 Roads Needs Study
- MTO Traffic Manuals
- Roads needs Study - Any major construction project is out lined in this study
- O.S.I.M. report - All bridges with a span of more then 3.5 meters are inspected every 2 years by a certified engineer
- Parks Master plan 2024
- Parks are inspected regularly by a trained person.



Did you know...

- The Township of Adjala-Tosorontio plows approximately 670 kilometers (km) of roads within its boundaries.
- The Township does not formally close roads to traffic due to weather conditions. Road closings due to poor weather is the responsibility of the Ontario Provincial Police.
- County Roads are the responsibility of the County of Simcoe, Highways are the responsibility of the MTO.
